BOTTOMS:

- Pants
 - Skirts
 - Capri pants
 - Shorts
 - Slacks

- (solid color only)

Belts are optional. *Shorts may be worn in August, September, October, April, May and June. They should be modest and loose fitting and not more than five inches above the knee.*

TOPS:

- Polo shirt
 - Shirt with collar
 - Blouse with collar
 - Turtleneck
- IN
- Navy blue
 - Gray
 - Yellow
 - White
 - Light blue

(solid color only; no logos or the SJA logo only, please)

Sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn over these tops if they are in one of the five solid colors above and have no logo or the SJA logo only.

Items that do not support the school's philosophy of nonviolence and the dignity of the human person are not allowed. This includes clothing or personal items that promote or support alcohol, drugs, gangs, profanity, sexual conduct and violence. These items are not allowed at school or any school sponsored function. Camouflage dress is not allowed. Camouflage is defined as brown, green, grey, military pattern material or orange hunting material.
